OVERCOMING FORCES THAT STAND AGAINST THE FULFILMENT OF PROPHECIES

For the vision is yet for an appointed time, but at the end it shall speak, and not lie: though it tarry, wait for it; because it will surely come, it will not tarry.

Habakkuk 2:3 (King James Version)

God does not speak as man does but speaks in His capacity as God. Whatever He says is already accomplished. However, we have responsibilities to fulfil to see God's prophecies come to pass in our lives.

Abraham obeyed God to the end to emerge as a symbol of generational blessing. He was seventy-five years old and a picture of failure the first time he encountered the word of prophecy. He had no house of his own; had a wife who had been chosen for him by his parents; had no child and was unemployed. God then spoke to him asking him to get out of where he was (Genesis 12:1, Genesis 12:4). He obeyed God even when he was asked to sacrifice his son (Genesis 22:1-3). By the time he was old, he was blessed in all things (Genesis 24:1). By obeying God, Abraham went from zero level to hero level (Galatians 3:13-14).

We also have the responsibility to take out the little foxes to enable us obtain the promises of God for us (Songs of Solomon 2:15). Christianity is a lifestyle with a benchmark so it must be pursued with sanctity (Galatians 6:7-8). Spirituality secures destiny. It goes beyond looks or

acts like speaking in tongues. It has to do with the way we think and address situations. It is about doing things the way of God.

Every prophetic word speaks loudest at the end (Habakkuk 2:1-3). God created time but lives outside time so He is not constrained by time. A testimony delayed is not a testimony denied but a testimony intensified (Galatians 6:9). From this premise, we know that we can still take full delivery of our 2017 prophetic package.

Forces we must resist to ensure fulfilment of prophecies

i. The evil heart of unbelief (Hebrews 3:12)

Unbelief is referred to as an evil heart. It is the faith in your heart that gives you your position in life (Hebrews 4:2). The entirety of the gospel is called the faith. This shows that faith is inevitable in the Christian race (Hebrews 11:6). For any prophetic word to be fulfilled you have to believe and God will surely perform (Luke 1:45; Romans 4:16-17). You look for the things you want and begin to call them into existence. Faith does not deny facts but looks beyond facts (Romans 4:20). Faith failure leads to destiny failure so always ensure your faith is well guarded

ii. The scourge of hopelessness (Romans 5:5)

Faith without hope is impotent because hope creates the atmosphere for faith to work

Spirituality Secures Destiny and Eternity - 1 Timothy 4:8

(Hebrews 11:1). Hope signifies expectation and anticipation. By redemption you are not permitted to be hopeless (1 Peter 1:13; Ecclesiastes 9:4). When you become hopeless, you become helpless. Keep your hope alive (Job 14:7-9; Job 14:14). Hope is the magnet that attracts grace in the race of life. If you do not give up, the devil will surely give in (Romans 15:4). Do not care about what is happening but focus on what is written in the word of God for it gives hope that does not bring shame (Romans 5:5, 2 Timothy 2:13).

How to resist hopelessness

- Protect your thoughts and imaginations (Proverbs 23:7; Proverbs 4:23);
- Feed on the word of God (Romans 15:4);
- Feed on testimonies (1 Peter 1:3).

iii. The misuse of the tongue (Matthew 12:36)

Align your speech with the word of God. Be careful about what you say. The tongue is able to

create crisis beyond what you envisage (James 3:5). Be careful to build up and not destroy with your tongue (Proverbs 18:21). Speak what you want into existence (Proverbs 18:20). You must mind what you say if you want to see God's prophecies fulfilled in your life (Psalm 34:12-13). You have the responsibility to choose what you say (Isaiah 63:7).

How to avoid misuse of the tongue

- Keep speaking the right words at all times (Luke 21:15);
- Reject and reverse any misguided statement;
- Speak what you read in the Scriptures (Joshua 1:8).

These forces cannot be overcome without the help of the Holy Spirit and engaging the mysteries of God's kingdom, like the Holy Communion. May your spirit, soul and body be renewed and reinvigorated.




PRAYER OF SALVATION
