UNDERSTANDING THE LAWS OF SUCCESS (PART 2)

**SUNDAY 21
APRIL 2019**

Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on an hill cannot be hid. **Matthew 5:14 (King James Version)**

As God's children, we are destined for the top and nothing can stop our destiny from moving forward. However, there are biblical steps required to get to the top (Joshua 1:8; Colossians 3:16). The steps are laws that govern success. When we understand and apply the laws that govern success, our profiting will be evident to all. Success is not accidental, neither does it happen by chance in the kingdom of God; it is a choice that is available to anyone that desires it. If we lack strategies to succeed then we are planning not to succeed. Our prosperity depends on us, the choices we make determine our future. Spiritual laws govern success from God: when we put these spiritual laws into practice, we can command supernatural breakthroughs (Romans 8:1-2). Spiritual laws are superior to all natural and scientific laws (James 3:15-16; Isaiah 55:8-9). Natural laws yield common results, but spiritual laws yield uncommon testimonies that are above all. Regardless of the circumstance, when we apply spiritual laws, we arrive at our desired end (Proverbs 11:30; Daniel 12:3; Matthew 6:33). One of the spiritual laws of success is the law of vision, which we covered in Part 1. Here we will be examining the law of discipline.

THE LAW OF DISCIPLINE

1. Life must be lived deliberately and not randomly, it must be lived by choice and not left to chance. The road we follow determines the place we end; if we do not know where we are going, we will not like where we will end up.

2. Although we have been redeemed to reign on the earth, indiscipline can rob any believer of his throne (Ecclesiastes 10:15-17; Galatians 4:1; Hosea 4:6). Life must be lived deliberately and not randomly, because the choices we make today determine our destination tomorrow. When we live unintentionally, the final outcome will be most likely undesirable. Without discipline, the position at the top is not guaranteed, for it takes discipline to maintain the top position that was secured by our redemption (Ecclesiastes 10:16-17). It takes discipline to secure the trust of God for riches in God's kingdom. Kingdom riches cannot be handed over to immature believers.

WHAT IS DISCIPLINE?

3. **Discipline is possessing a sense of mission in the pursuit of any task** – (1Corinthians 6:12). We must live life intentionally, recognising that we have a mission. God will assess what we do with the resources we have before releasing more blessings. Discipline requires that we follow God's instructions rather than living a life of convenience (Nehemiah 4:23). Daniel determined in his heart not to live like the people of his time and he was able to make a difference in his God given assignment (Daniel 1:8). Following the crowd makes us lose sight of our God's plan for us but when we live in obedience to God's instruction, we command dominion. The instructions may seem inconvenient today, but will guarantee glory tomorrow.

4. **Discipline is all about making the most of one's time** (Ephesians 5:14-16). Discipline requires us to make the most of our time and reject spiritual slumber. When we manage our time, we manage our life (Ephesians 5:14-16). We must not allow procrastination to steal our time for nothing can hinder us from achieving success if we discipline ourselves. Discipline enabled Joseph to be recognised in Potiphar's house (Genesis 39:1-6).

5. **Self-discipline is being a law to one's self in a bid to accomplish a given task** (1Corinthians 10:23).

6. **It is operating as commanded and not as convenient** (Nehemiah 4:23). It is also putting our body under control, the ability to say no and actually say it. Discipline is not subject to fear. Having discipline enables us choose a life that is different so we can make a difference. It is making the most of our time as God expects us to be accountable for how we spend our time. It is being in command of situations and taking steps as commanded not as convenient.

7. No one will ever be more distinguished in his pursuit than he who is disciplined (Daniel 6:5-10; Daniel 6:28; 1 Corinthians 10:23). Daniel and Joseph are examples of men who were disciplined (Genesis 39:1-5; Genesis 39:9; Genesis 39:20-23; Genesis 41:38-44).

AREAS IN NEED OF DISCIPLINE

- 1. Sleeping habits:** An over indulgence in sleep leads to penury (Proverbs 20:13). A determined heart on a mission will keep sleep and shame away (Proverbs 6:4).
- 2. Eating habits:** We must cultivate moderation and dignity in our eating habits.
- 3. Spending habits:** It is unwise to be distracted by momentary and unplanned expenditure.
- 4. Dressing:** Our dressing must indicate

our redeemed place at the top in every endeavour. Dress in an edifying and dignified manner.

5. Speech: We should be considerate in our speech and mind our business. We must avoid tearing down our life by our speech (James 3:2; Proverbs 21:23).

6. Time management: Diligence is required in keeping and managing time, time is life currency, and you either spend it or invest it. Time management is life management.

NEXT LEVEL BANQUET

We move forward every time we appear before the presence of God and secure our next level blessings as far as our eyes can see. Obedience to God's word is what enables us to experience next level blessings.

THINGS TO NOTE FOR NEXT LEVELS BANQUET

By redemption, we have been empowered for a life of continuous progress (Proverbs 4:18; Romans 8:28-29).

God is committed to our continuous progress (Exodus 14:15; Deuteronomy 2:3; Micah 2:10).

Benefits of Next Level blessings

i. Rapid change of position - Next level blessings enables the believer to constantly change position suddenly and in quick succession.

ii. Unending breakthroughs - God has designed the believer to continuously increase (Proverbs 4:18; 2 Corinthians 3:18).

iii. Continuous Progress - God is committed to our continuous progress (Exodus 14:15; Deuteronomy 2:3; Micah 2:10). Until we move from our current position, we cannot get to our destination.

There are covenant steps to take to encounter next levels, which is already prepared for us.

TEN STEPS TO CHANGING LEVELS

1. Appreciation: Continue to celebrate the faithfulness of God no matter what. Our gratitude is the springboard for greatness. We have an obligation to show our gratitude to God (Jeremiah 30:19; Habakkuk 3:17-19; Psalms 28:5). We may not be where we want to be, but we are

not where we used to be. Instead of complaining, we should offer praise and thanksgiving unto God (1 Corinthians 10:10; Psalm 67:5-7). Until we thank God for past levels we cannot move to next levels. An attitude of gratitude will enhance our altitude.

2. Reaction: We must continue to grow in our understanding of the Word, thereby growing from faith to faith and then from glory to glory (Acts 8:26-35). At the point our faith is birth, reaction is what occurs. Never settle for mediocrity or failure. We must grow in our understanding of God's word and use it to move forward.

3. Vision: Possess a next level shift mentality - To move forward, we need to consider the new thing God wants to do (Genesis 13:14-15). When we see it, then we can seize it.

4. Divine guidance: Divine guidance teaches us how to profit (Genesis 26:1-14; Isaiah 48:17). To navigate new gates, you will need accurate description.

5. Revelation: New light for new heights - We need fresh insight to walk in the next levels prepared by God. As such, we must hold onto the instructions from God's word (Isaiah 60:1; Proverbs 4:13; 8:4; Galatians 2:2). Following every instruction from scriptures is gateway to continuous progress.

6. Courage - Change of levels happens when we step out of our comfort zone (Exodus 14:13-15; Joshua 1:3; Joshua 1:9). When we move in obedience to God's instructions, God changes our level. Therefore, we must refuse to walk in fear. Continuity in our walk with God is the core covenant requirement for continuous change of levels in life (Acts 26:22).

8. Engage prophetic assistance – We must make use of the prophetic covering available to us (Ezra 4:23; Ezra 5:1- 2; Ezra 6:14).

9. Be a kingdom service addict – We must be committed to engaging in kingdom service as a lifestyle (Job 36:11; Luke 19:13-19; Matthew 6:33). Serving God and the interest of His kingdom as a lifestyle, guarantees unstoppable progress

10. Prayers – We can alter our destiny on the altar of prayer. Jabez prayed and his future was transformed (2 Chronicles 4:10; Luke 9:28-29).

Applying the laws of success to arrive at the top can only be achieved when we acknowledge Jesus Christ as our personal Lord and Saviour. 
